### **BUSINESS PARTNERSHIP EXAMPLES:**

#### Franciscan Health

- Joint curriculum for Health Careers Academy developed between A.K. Smith and Franciscan staff
- EMT and Health Careers students engage in clinical rounds with hospital staff to create a deeper awareness of field-related workforce opportunities
- New scholarship opportunities were developed in 2022 for LaPorte County students entering healthcare professions as an incentive to return
- Outreach/site visits by MCHS seniors re: non-degree opportunities in areas such as food service and facilities maintenance

#### Horizon Bank

- Employs students as tellers (supervised by Horizon employee)
- Continued employment of students as summer interns and in college towns, if a bank branch exists

- Entrepreneurship program with Early College students

### Howmet (formerly Alcoa/Arconic)

- Funded manufacturing equipment and training for teacher certification in Computer Integrated Manufacturing at MCHS
- Grant supported robotics expansion and compressed-air academy programs
- Funded teacher training for Project Lead the Way pre-engineering (civil, mechanical, and architectural engineering)

#### NIPSCO

- Provided funding and technical support for the development of the Energy Academy at A. K. Smith
- Hiring opportunities are available at NIPSCO and related companies


Dual Credits Earned: 3,047 AP Classes completed: 550
